

# About

Kokerbin Rock, reputed to be the 3rd largest monolith in Australia, is approx. 50kms from Bruce Rock.

In 1863, early explorer Henry Maxwell Lefroy, on discovering it, said in his diary:

*"Late in the afternoon we reached Karkabin (now Kokerbin) which is certainly one of the most remarkable and interesting rocks which I have seen in WA"*

To this day it is still regarded this way. It offers the traveller bush walks, wonderful views, unique rock formations, flora and fauna to be observed. There is a picnic spot with water and toilet facilities, barbecues and is a great favourite amongst visitors. It is also a popular venue for vintage and 4 wheel drive clubs, while still retaining its unspoilt natural environment.

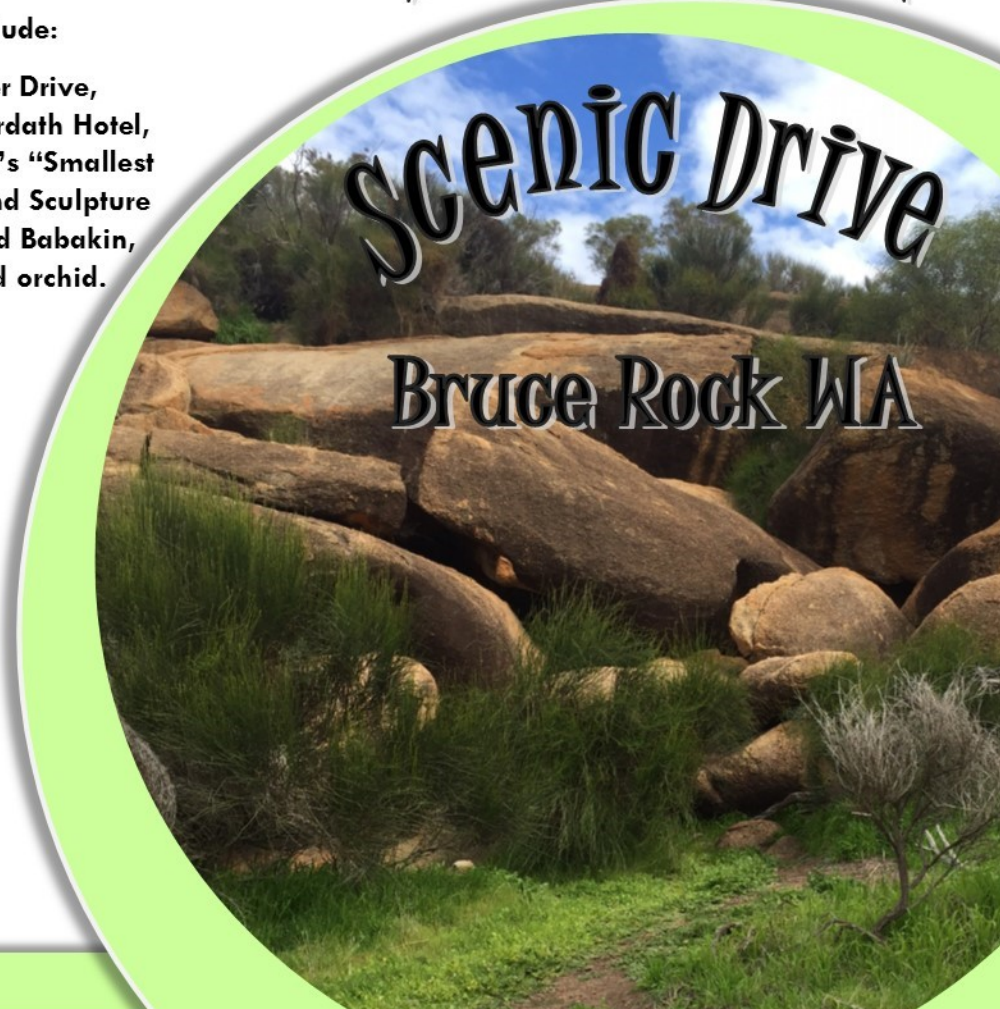
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# Kokerbin Rock



# Directions

The starting point is on the North - Western edge of the Bruce Rock town site, at the start of Doodlakine Road.

Head North - West out of town

5kms - turn left (west) onto Sippe Rd

13.8kms - turn left onto Liebeck Rd

0.5kms - turn right onto Massam Rd

8kms - at T-junction - turn right onto Ardath - Yarding Rd

0.2km - turn left onto Bozanich Rd

1.5kms - turn right onto Jakovich Rd

1.7kms - at T-junction - turn left onto Yerapin Boundary Rd

3.7kms - at T-junction - turn left onto Langdon Rd

1.2kms - turn right onto Hortin Rd

4.7kms - at intersection - cross directly across Shackleton Rd

4kms - at T-junction - turn left onto Kwolyin East Rd



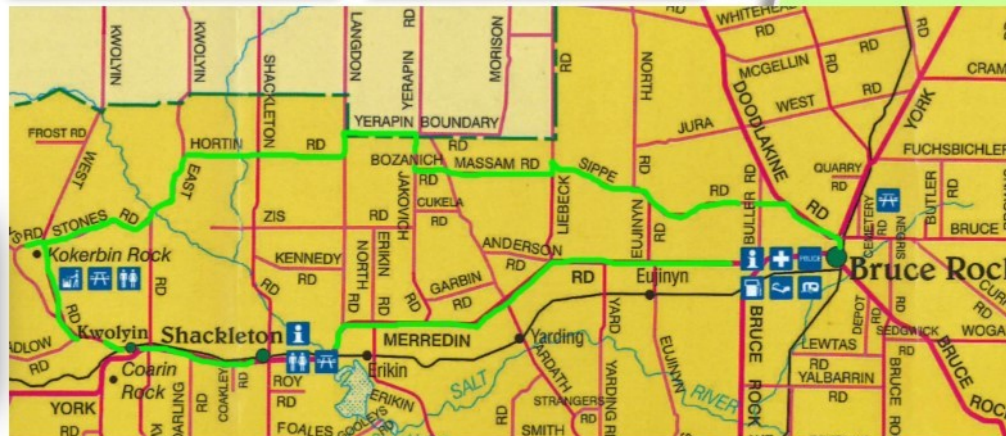
2.5kms - travel through Kwolyin Nature Reserve, another 1km further on you can look to the right and view Mt Caroline (nth) and Mt Stirling (sth) in the distance

4.1kms - turn right onto Stones Rd, see a granite outcrop on the right and wildflowers in the spring

6.4kms - at intersection, cross directly across Kwolyin West Rd

0.5km - turn left into Kokerbin Nature Reserve

0.6km - arrive at Kokerbin picnic spot. Here you will find picnic tables, a BBQ, toilets and information boards. From here follow the arrows to the base of Kokerbin Rock. Camping is only available at the Kwolyin Campsite.



# Kwolyin Campsite

Proceed back the way you came along O'Gradys Rd, then turn right onto Kwolyin West Rd at the intersection

9.6kms - turn right at the sign "Kwolyin Campground". Look out for Interpretative signage along the way, giving glimpses into the life of the town of Kwolyin in days past.

0.3km - turn into the camp ground entry.

The Kwolyin Campsite offers quiet, secluded camping spots, toilets and a camp kitchen. There are three marked walks of varying distances.

If you wish to drive back to Bruce Rock, you can either drive back along the Scenic Drive, or turn right (south) onto the Kwolyin West Rd, then left (east) onto the Bruce Rock - Quairading Rd for a quicker, direct route into Bruce Rock.
